Introduction

Renewable energy projects are understood to be non-conventional ones, in implementation process or implemented, with or without cost and the technologies that can range from: wind energy, solar photovoltaic, geothermal, biomass, biogas and recovery energy from urban or similar waste.

Applications

- All public and private entities from member countries of the Latin American Energy Organization (OLADE) that have technologies, projects implemented or being implemented since January 1, 2021 until June 1, 2024 may apply.
- Applications will only be received by email at Premio.excelenciaenergetica@olade.org until September 20, 2024, inclusive.
- Items that must be included in the application:
 - Presentation of the project with a maximum of 800 words (according to the specifications found in ANNEX I)..
 - Letter signed by a representative of the institution indicating the willingness to participate and accepting these terms and conditions.
 - General form (ANEX I).
 - Optionally, up to a maximum of 3 pages of complementary information may be submitted, either graphic material or text. If graphic material is presented, its content must be correctly described.
- The presentation must include the following information
 - Impacted people (include accounting methodology).
 - Useful life of the expected stockings in years.
 - Installed power MW.
 - Plant factor.
 - Total Project investment.
 - Installed power of the electrical system where it is connected.
 - Date of entry into operation of the project.

- Annual production capacity of machinery and equipment by the company or institution. Mandatory only if it corresponds to a technology.
- Communication and dissemination policies: indicate the dissemination policies carried out, future communication plans and the population impacted. As well as results obtained through its dissemination and communication policies.
- It must be sent the company logo, in vector format (.eps or .pdf), and at least 5 good quality photos (300 dpi). These will be used in future dissemination materials. One of the photos must be of the frontage of the entity. It can be a frontal or aerial photograph. It must be a representative photograph of the entity. The rest of the photos must be of the measures and activities (implementation, management, training, dissemination) presented.
- All the information provided by the applicant is considered true and of his own intellectual property. It's the responsibility of the participant to take the necessary steps to ensure this.
- Olade reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions of the Olade Award for Energy Excellence at any time during this call. If modifications are made, they will be published on the institutional website. Any modification of the terms and conditions will be made prior to the closing date for receiving applications.

Considerations

- **Public entities:** Public entities are defined as all those organizations whose management is entirely carried out by the national government, subnational governments and local governments (mayors or local governments).
- **Private entities:** defined as all those national organizations not included in the definition of public entities.
- **Size:**
 - Public sector: the project is considered medium or small if it impacts a population of less than 4,000 people and large if it impacts a population equal to or greater than 4,000 people.
 - Private sector: any organization that has fewer than 150 employees is considered small or medium, and any organization that has 150 or more employees is considered large.
- By presenting themselves, the entities declare that they comply with the corresponding current national regulations. The entity may be excluded from the award in the event of non-compliance, even once has been granted a prize.
- By presenting themselves, the entities declare that they allow a visit to the facilities, provide complementary information and/or present the project to the Evaluation Committee, if requested.
- The entities will allow OLADE to use the information about the achievements obtained to promote the efficient use of energy.
